Actual Paid Operations Expenses are shown for comparison to income. *Plate* is weekly collection income. *Other* includes baptisms, funerals, weddings, candles, fundraising, holy day donations, misc. donations, & facility rental income. *Second Collection* income is paid to other organizations and not used for parish operations. *Year to Date* is the cumulative total for the fiscal year-- July 1 through June 30th.
